GeoEnergy23—international conference 5.-6. June in Bergen

Save the date for the upcoming GeoEnergy 2023 conference in Bergen 5.-6. June! The invitation is being sent out these days. The NRC funding for such activities were closed this year and we are inviting CGER network partners for sponsorship to make the event happen.

Member meetings and network activities

We have an ambitious program in CGER this semester with geothermal road show with network meetings in Oslo, Bergen and Kristiansand. We started off with a successful CGER matchmaking workshop in Oslo the 26th January where industry met academia to learn to know each other and to develop strong research and development projects (acknowledge NRC). Then we moved on to Bergen the 16th February where we had a meeting and visit to the energy wells in HVL (acknowledge Bergen Kommune). Then, the 7th of March we arranged a joint session with GCE Node in Kristiansand with a talks and stimulating discussions on the use of underground heat.

We have promoted how Geothermal energy solutions contribute to solve challenges in our time:
